HOUSE BILL DRH40329-MLf-170 (03/28)

Short Title: "Kick Cancer for Kids" Special Plate. (Public)

Sponsors: Representative Hurley.

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO PRODUCE A  
3 "KICK CANCER FOR KIDS" SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration plates:

7 ...

8 () Kick Cancer for Kids. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle  
9 in accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate shall bear the words "Kick  
10 Cancer for Kids" and a representation of a gold ribbon with children's  
11 handprints surrounding the ribbon.

12 ...."

13 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 20-79.7 reads as rewritten:

14 "§ 20-79.7. Fees for special registration plates and distribution of the fees.

15 ...

16 (a1) Fees. – All other special registration plates are subject to the regular motor vehicle  
17 registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee in the following amount:

23 (b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate  
24 and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division  
25 must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a)  
26 of this section among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and  
27 Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), the Clean Water Management Trust Fund  
28 (CWMTF), which is established under G.S. 113A-253, and the Parks and Recreation Trust  
29 Fund, which is established under G.S. 113-44.15, as follows:

35 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 20-81.12 reads as rewritten:

36 "§ 20-81.12. Collegiate insignia plates and certain other special plates.

2 (b155) Kick Cancer for Kids. – The applicable requirements of G.S. 20-79.3A shall be met  
3 before the Kick Cancer for Kids plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly  
4 the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of  
5 Kick Cancer for Kids plates as follows:

- 6 (1) Fifty percent (50%) to The Children's Oncology Group Foundation to be  
7 used to provide support for the mission and goals of the Foundation.
- 8 (2) Fifty percent (50%) to Riley's Army, Inc., to be used to provide support to  
9 children with cancer and their families.

10 ...."  
11 **SECTION 4.** The Revisor of Statutes is authorized to alphabetize, number, and  
12 renumber the special registration plates listed in G.S. 20-79.4(b) to ensure that all the special  
13 registration plates are listed in alphabetical order and numbered accordingly.

14 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2017.
