## 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THAT POSSESSION OF CERTAIN PRESCRIPTION DRUGS IS 3 NOT PUNISHABLE AS TRAFFICKING IN OPIUM OR HEROIN AND TO SET OUT 4 THE CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR THAT OFFENSE. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 90-95(h)(4) reads as rewritten: 7 Any-Except as provided in subdivision (4c) of this subsection, any person "(4) who sells, manufactures, delivers, transports, or possesses four grams or 8 9 more of opium or opiate, or any salt, compound, derivative, or preparation of opium or opiate (except apomorphine, nalbuphine, analoxone and naltrexone 10 and their respective salts), including heroin, or any mixture containing such 11 substance, shall be guilty of a felony which felony shall be known as 12 "trafficking in opium or heroin" and if the quantity of such controlled 13 substance or mixture involved: 14 15 Is four grams or more, but less than 14 grams, such person shall be a. punished as a Class F felon and shall be sentenced to a minimum 16 17 term of 70 months and a maximum term of 93 months in the State's prison and shall be fined not less than fifty thousand dollars 18 19 (\$50,000); Is 14 grams or more, but less than 28 grams, such person shall be 20 b. punished as a Class E felon and shall be sentenced to a minimum 21 22 term of 90 months and a maximum term of 120 months in the State's prison and shall be fined not less than one hundred thousand dollars 23 (\$100,000); 24 25 Is 28 grams or more, such person shall be punished as a Class C c. felon and shall be sentenced to a minimum term of 225 months and a 26 maximum term of 282 months in the State's prison and shall be fined 27 not less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)." 28 29 SECTION 2. G.S. 90-95(h) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(4c) The illegal sale, delivery, transportation, or possession of pills, tablets, or 30 31 capsules of a controlled substance that contains an opiate, as defined in G.S. 90-87(18), combined with a noncontrolled substance and that is a 32 commercial drug product with FDA approval manufactured and distributed 33 by a pharmaceutical company lawfully doing business in the United States 34 shall be governed by this section and by subsections (b) and (d) of this 35
