1 A SENATE RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2017 SENATE PERMANENT RULES.

2 Be it resolved by the Senate:

3 **SECTION 1.** Rule 32 of the 2017 Senate Permanent Rules, as contained in Senate
4 Resolution 1, as amended by Senate Resolution 459, as enacted during the 2017 Regular
5 Session of the 2017 General Assembly, reads as rewritten:

6 "RULE 32. **List of standing/select committees.** – The standing committees shall be:

7 Agriculture/Environment/Natural Resources

8 Appropriations/Base Budget

9 Appropriations on Department of Transportation

10 Appropriations on Education/Higher Education

11 Appropriations on General Government and Information Technology

12 Appropriations on Health and Human Services

13 Appropriations on Justice and Public Safety

14 Appropriations on Agriculture, Natural, and Economic Resources

15 ~~Appropriations on Pensions, Compensation, and Benefits~~

16 Commerce and Insurance

17 Committee of the Whole Senate

18 Education/Higher Education

25 Transportation"

26 **SECTION 2.** Rule 41 of the 2017 Senate Permanent Rules, as contained in Senate
27 Resolution 1, as amended by Senate Resolution 459, as enacted during the 2017 Regular
28 Session of the 2017 General Assembly, reads as rewritten:

29 "RULE 41. **Crossover bill deadline.** – In order to be eligible for consideration by the
30 Senate during the 2017 or 2018 Regular Session of the 2017 General Assembly, all House bills
31 other than (i) those required to be referred to the Committee on Finance or the Committee on
32 Appropriations/Base Budget by Rule 42, (ii) those establishing districts for Congress or State or
33 local entities, ~~or~~ (iii) those providing for amendments to the North Carolina Constitution, (iv)
34 those containing statutory amendments necessary to implement proposed amendments to the
35 North Carolina Constitution, (v) those ratifying an amendment or amendments to the
36 Constitution of the United States, or (vi) adjournment resolutions must be received and read on
37 the floor of the Senate as a message from the House no later than Thursday, April 27, 2017,



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1 provided that a message from the House received by the next legislative day stating that a bill
2 has passed its third reading and is being engrossed shall comply with the requirements of this
3 rule and provided that the House accepts Senate bills ordered engrossed on the next legislative
4 day."

5 **SECTION 3.** Rule 42.2(a) of the 2017 Senate Permanent Rules, as contained in
6 Senate Resolution 1, as amended by Senate Resolution 459, as enacted during the 2017 Regular
7 Session of the 2017 General Assembly, reads as rewritten:

8 "RULE 42.2. **Actuarial notes.** – (a) Every bill or resolution proposing any change in the
9 law relative to any:

10 (1) State, municipal, or other retirement system funded in whole or in part out of
11 public funds; or

12 (2) Program of hospital, medical, disability, or related benefits provided for
13 teachers and State employees, funded in whole or in part by State funds,

14 shall have attached to it at the time of its consideration by any committee a brief
15 explanatory statement or note that shall include a reliable estimate of the financial and actuarial
16 effect of the proposed change, as provided in G.S. 120-114. The actuarial note shall be attached
17 to the jacket of each proposed bill or resolution that is reported favorably by any committee and
18 shall be clearly designated as an actuarial note. Upon its introduction, a bill or resolution
19 described in subdivision (a)(1) of this rule shall be referred to the ~~Appropriations Committee on~~
20 ~~Pensions, Compensation, and Benefits~~ and such referral shall constitute compliance with
21 ~~G.S. 120-111.3.~~ Committee on Pensions and Retirement and Aging."

22 **SECTION 4.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
