1 moves to amend the bill on page 73, lines 21-22,  
2 by inserting between those lines the following:

3 **"ESTABLISH LEGISLATIVE SCHOOL FOR LEADERSHIP AND PUBLIC**  
4 **SERVICE/GOVERNOR'S SCHOOL FUNDS**

5 **SECTION 10.16.(a)** The General Assembly finds that it is important to recognize  
6 students who have talent and potential as leaders and to provide opportunities and training for  
7 students to develop and explore their leadership skills. The General Assembly further finds it is  
8 important to prepare students who display leadership skills to lead in responsible, positive ways  
9 and to provide a variety of settings for students to practice and strengthen leadership talents.  
10 The General Assembly also recognizes that the community involvement and public services  
11 performed by students seeking to fulfill their leadership potential provides an invaluable benefit  
12 to the State and its citizens.

13 **SECTION 10.16.(b)** The Legislative School for Leadership and Public Service is  
14 established within The University of North Carolina General Administration. The School shall  
15 be a summer residential program for academically gifted high school students that offers a  
16 course of study on leadership development and public service that is academically excellent  
17 and that also provides an outstanding and unique educational experience.

18 The Board of Governors shall determine which constituent institution shall be the  
19 site and sponsor of the program and, in consultation and collaboration with the constituent  
20 institution shall design and implement an application and nomination process for students  
21 interested in attending the program and the criteria and process to be used to determine  
22 admissions to the program. The curriculum for the program shall be designed by the  
23 constituent institution based on criteria established by the Board of Governors and is subject to  
24 the approval of the Board of Governors.

25 The constituent institution shall administer the Legislative School for Leadership  
26 and Public Service in consultation and collaboration with The University of North Carolina  
27 Office of General Administration.

28 **SECTION 10.16.(c)** G.S. 116-11 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:  
29 "(13b.) The Board of Governors may authorize the constituent institution selected by  
30 the Board as the site and sponsor for the Legislative School for Leadership  
31 and Public Service to implement a tuition charge for students attending the  
32 School to cover the costs of the School."

1           **SECTION 10.16.(d).** Part 3 of Article 1 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is  
2 amended by adding a new section to read:

3 **"§ 116-33.3. Tuition for Legislative School for Leadership and Public Service.**

4           The Board of Trustees of any constituent institution selected by the Board of Governors as  
5 the site and sponsor for the Legislative School for Leadership and Public Service may, with the  
6 approval of the Board of Governors, implement a tuition charge for students attending the  
7 School to cover the costs of the School."

8           **SECTION 10.16(e)** Of the funds appropriated by this act to the Board of Governors  
9 for the 2018-2019 fiscal year the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) shall be used  
10 to support the Summer Ventures Program. The funds shall be allocated equally among the  
11 constituent institutions that offer the Summer Ventures Program.

12           **SECTION 10.16.(f)** The Legislative School for Leadership and Public Service  
13 created by this act shall be offered beginning on or after July 1, 2018, and shall be offered each  
14 subsequent summer semester." ; and

16 Further moves to amend the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget money report on page F-13,  
17 Item 32 (Governor's School of North Carolina) by deleting the reduction for that item for the  
18 2017-2018 fiscal year.; and

19  
20 further moves to amend the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget money report on page F-33,  
21 Item 61 (Centers and Institutes) by increasing the reduction for each fiscal year by \$800,000;  
22 and

24 further moves to amend the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget money report on page F-34, by  
25 adding a new item to read:
