**"SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission is directed to study the  
impacts of wireless technology and to include in the study the following:

- (1) The extent to which, if any, wireless facilities release radiation in the atmosphere.
- (2) Whether any radiation that may be released by wireless facilities is in amounts sufficient to be harmful to the public health.
- (3) Whether 5G wireless facilities create risks to public health in excess of existing 3G service.
- (4) A comparison between the costs and benefits of fiber optic cable service against that of wireless service taking into consideration the relative costs and any public health concerns between the two service methods.
- (5) Whether wireless facilities are a method of providing telecommunication services to rural and underserved areas.
- (6) Any other relevant matter.

**SECTION 2.** The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim  
report to the 2018 General Assembly when it reconvenes in 2018 and shall make its final report
