"SECTION 2.1(a) G.S. 20-4.01 is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

"(12h) High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle (HMMWV). – A four-wheel drive light truck produced for military or government use and commonly referred to as a "HMMWV" or Humvee."

SECTION 2.1(b) G.S. 20-50 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

Notwithstanding G.S. 20-54, the Division may issue a title and registration to a High Mobility Multipurpose Wheeled Vehicle (HMMWV) sold by a licensed motor vehicle dealer if the manufacturer or dealer of the HMMWV provides a sworn affidavit certifying that the vehicle is safe for highway use and that the HMMWV complies with all federal motor vehicle safety standards applicable to such motor vehicle for highway use. No title shall be issued to a vehicle prior to the completion of a vehicle verification conducted by the License and Theft Bureau of the Division. This inspection shall consist of verifying the existence of a public vehicle identification number and ensuring that it matches the vehicle and ownership documents. If the vehicle does not have a manufacturer assigned vehicle identification number acceptable to the Division, the Division shall assign one to the vehicle prior to registration. Any HMMWV to be registered under this section must be inspected in accordance with Article 3A of this Chapter and insured in accordance with Article 9A of this Chapter prior to registration. The Division and the License and Theft Bureau shall not be liable for any injuries
