- 24 Fisheries of the Department of Environmental Quality shall implement the Importation of
- 25 Marine and Estuarine Organisms Rule, as provided in subsection (c) of this section.
- 26 SECTION 3.1(c) Implementation. – Use of American eels imported from Virginia
- 27 or South Carolina in an aquaculture operation is exempt from the permitting requirements of
- 28 the Importation of Marine and Estuarine Organisms Rule .
- 29 SECTION 3.1(d) Additional Rule-Making Authority. – The Commission shall
- 30 adopt a rule to amend the Importation of Marine and Estuarine Organisms Rule consistent with
- 31 subsection (c) of this section. Notwithstanding G.S. 150B-19(4), the rule adopted by the
- 32 Commission, pursuant to this section, shall be substantively identical to the provisions of
