4 **"STUDY FLOOD PREVENTION MEASURES IN THE LOWER NEUSE RIVER**
5 **BASIN**

6 **SECTION 21.2.** The Legislative Research Commission shall study flood control
7 measures to prevent flooding damage to persons and property in the Lower Neuse River Basin.
8 The Commission shall specifically consider construction of flood control reservoirs along the
9 Neuse River; identification of alternative water supplies for the City of Raleigh that would
10 allow lowering of Falls Lake during times of anticipated flooding; additional mitigation by the
11 North Carolina Department of Transportation to address significant stormwater impacts from
12 highway construction; and active "snag, drag, and dredge" operations within the Neuse River
13 and its tributaries to reduce obstructions to flow and removal of materials that would impact the
14 flood level of the river. The Commission shall report the results of its study, including any
15 findings and recommendations, to the 2018 Regular Session of the 2017 General Assembly."
