 2 by rewriting those lines to read:
 3 **"ALLOW RESTAURANTS TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BEFORE NOON**
 4 **ON SUNDAYS, SUBJECT TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT APPROVAL**
 5 **SECTION 4.(a)** G.S. 18B-1004(c) reads as rewritten:
 6 **"§ 18B-1004. Hours for sale and consumption.**
 7 ...
 8 (c) Sunday Hours. – ~~It—~~Except as authorized pursuant to G.S. 18B-112(b1),
 9 G.S. 153A-145.7, or G.S. 160A-205.3, it shall be unlawful to sell or consume alcoholic
 10 beverages on any licensed premises from the time at which sale or consumption must cease on
 11 Sunday morning until 12:00 Noon on that day."
 12 **SECTION 4.(b)** Article 6 of Chapter 153A of the General Statutes is amended by
 13 adding a new section to read:
 14 **"§ 153A-145.7. Hours of certain alcohol sales at restaurants.**
 15 In accordance with G.S. 18B-1004(c), a county may adopt an ordinance allowing licensed
 16 restaurants to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption beginning at 10:00 A.M.
 17 on Sunday morning pursuant to the restaurant's on-premises malt beverage permit, on-premises
 18 unfortified wine permit, on-premises fortified wine permit, or mixed beverages permit."
 19 **SECTION 4.(c)** Article 8 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes is amended by
 20 adding a new section to read:
 21 **"§ 160A-205.3. Hours of certain alcohol sales at restaurants.**
 22 In accordance with G.S. 18B-1004(c), a city may adopt an ordinance allowing licensed
 23 restaurants to sell alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption beginning at 10:00 A.M.
 24 on Sunday morning pursuant to the restaurant's on-premises malt beverage permit, on-premises
 25 unfortified wine permit, on-premises fortified wine permit, or mixed beverages permit."
 26 **SECTION 4.(d)** G.S. 18B-112 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
 27 "(b1) In accordance with G.S. 18B-1004(c), the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians tribe
 28 may adopt an ordinance allowing licensed restaurants to sell alcoholic beverages for on-
 29 premises consumption beginning at 10:00 A.M. on Sunday pursuant to the restaurant's on-
 30 premises malt beverage permit, on-premises unfortified wine permit, on-premises fortified wine
 31 permit, or mixed beverages permit issued under the authority of G.S. 18B-112(d)."
