6	"PART IV. HICKORY AND CONOVER OCCUPANCY TAX
7	SECTION 4.1.(a) Section 1(d) of S.L. 2009-169 reads as rewritten:
8	"SECTION 1.(d) Distribution and Use of Tax Revenue. – The City of Hickory
9	shall, on a quarterly basis, remit the net proceeds of the occupancy tax to the Hickory-Conove
10	Tourism Development Authority. The funds remitted under this subsection must be used a
11	follows:
12	(1) Through December 31, 2019. 2029. – Prior to and through December 31
13	2019, 2029, the Authority may use two-thirds of the funds remitted to i
14	under this subsection for improving, leasing, constructing, financing
15	operating, or acquiring facilities and properties as needed to provide for a
16	convention center facility, including parking facilities for the convention
17	center. The remainder of the funds must be used to promote travel and
18	tourism. Debt issued to finance these improvements or facilities and that is
19	secured by occupancy tax proceeds remitted under this subdivision mus
20	mature on or before December 31, 2019.2029.
21	(2) After December 31, 2019. <u>2029.</u> – After December 31, 2019, <u>2029</u> , the
22	Authority must use at least two-thirds of the funds remitted to it under thi

24	remainder for tourism-related expenditures."
25	SECTION 4.1.(b) Section 3(d) of S.L. 2009-169 reads as rewritten:
26	"SECTION 3.(d) Distribution and Use of Tax Revenue. – The City of Conove
27	shall, on a quarterly basis, remit the net proceeds of the occupancy tax to the Hickory-Conove
28	Tourism Development Authority. The funds remitted under this subsection must be used a
29	follows:
30	(1) Through December 31, 2019.2029.— Prior to and through December 31
31	2019, 2029, the Authority may use two-thirds of the funds remitted to i
32	under this subsection for improving, leasing, constructing, financing
