Senator D. Davis

1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 11-12, by rewriting those lines to read as follows:
2 "APPROVED PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM; TO ENSURE
3 COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL LAW FOR IN-STATE TUITION FOR VETERANS; AND
4 TO PROHIBIT THE CLOSURE OF THE EASTERN CAROLINA STATE VETERANS
5 CEMETERY IN GOLDSBORO.";

7 And on page 4, lines 9-11, by rewriting those lines to read as follows:
8 "SECTION 5. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) shall
9 not close any of the State-owned veterans cemeteries. DMVA shall continue to operate all the
10 State-owned veterans cemeteries and shall maintain the current level of operations at each of
11 those cemeteries. The Office of State Budget and Management shall realign the base budget for
12 the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs for the 2017-2019 fiscal biennium to increase
13 receipts and include operational costs of the Eastern Carolina State Veterans Cemetery in
14 Goldsboro.

15 SECTION 6. Section 5 of this act is effective when this act becomes law. Section
16 4 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2017. The remainder of this act is effective when it
17 becomes law. Sections 1 and 2 of this act apply beginning with the 2017 fall academic
18 semester."
