

4 Government Parking Complex in accordance with G.S. 143-340(18a).";

7 "**SECTION 2.** G.S. 143-340 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
8 "(18a) To allocate to the General Assembly, upon 30 days' written notice, the
9 number of parking spaces requested by the Legislative Services Commission
10 Officer in Lot 7 of the State Government Parking Complex. The allocation
11 of parking spaces under this subdivision is not subject to the approval of the
12 Governor and the Council of State."

13 "**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding G.S. 120-32.1, as amended by Section 1 of this act,
14 any State employee who, as a result of a disability, previously has been
15 assigned a parking space in State Parking Deck 65 prior to the effective date
16 of this act, may apply to the Legislative Services Officer for accessible
17 parking.";
