

### NORTH CAROLINA GENERAL ASSEMBLY **AMENDMENT House Bill 482**

#### Senator Daniel

moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 3, by inserting after the word "ACQUISITION" and 1 2 before the period the following:

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"AND TO STUDY THE FINANCIAL COSTS TO THE STATE AND LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS OF COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL MANDATES RELATED TO THE RECEIPT OF FEDERAL EDUCATION FUNDING AND TO ESTABLISH A JOINT LEGISLATIVE TASK FORCE ON SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST IN STUDENT ATHLETES";

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And on page 1, between lines 18-19, by inserting the following:

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"SECTION 1.1(a) By no later than January 15, 2018, the Department of Public Instruction shall study, report, and provide any supporting data to the Fiscal Research Division and the Program Evaluation Division of the General Assembly on the cost of compliance with federal education funding mandates to local school administrative units.

**SECTION 1.1(b)** The Joint Legislative Program Evaluation Oversight Committee shall consider including in the 2017-2018 Work Plan for the Program Evaluation Division an evaluation of the cost of compliance with federal education funding mandates for K-12 education and, if included in the Work Plan, report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly at a date to be determined by the Committee.

**SECTION 1.1(c)** This section is effective when it becomes law.

SECTION 1.3(a) There is created the Joint Legislative Task Force on Sudden Cardiac Arrest in Student Athletes (Task Force).

**SECTION 1.3(b)** The Task Force shall consist of seven members as follows:

- Two members of the Senate appointed upon the recommendation of the (1) President Pro Tempore of the Senate, with one of those members serving as a cochair.
- Two members of the House of Representatives appointed upon the (2) recommendation of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, with one of those members serving as a cochair.
- The Secretary of Health and Human Services or his or her designee. (3)
- The Superintendent of Public Instruction or his or her designee. (4)
