17	"SECTION 1. There is established the Joint Legislative Study Committee on the
18 19	Appropriate Size of Local School Administrative Units (Committee). The Committee shall
20	consist of five members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House of
20	Representatives. The President Pro Tempore and the Speaker of the House of the
22	Representatives shall each appoint a cochair of the Committee from among its membership.
23	The Committee and the terms of the members shall expire when the Committee submits a final
24	report to the General Assembly. Members shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing officer.
25	SECTION 2. The Committee shall study whether there is an appropriate size for
26	local school administrative units. In conducting the study, the Committee shall consider
27	financial and administrative efficiencies and how those relate to the size of local school
28	administrative units. The Committee shall consider possible estimated cost savings and
29	possible estimated additional appropriations that may result if changes are made to the size of
30	local school administrative units in the State. Finally, the Committee shall study possible
31	avenues to consolidate or divide local school administrative units, including whether changes to
32	the size of a local school administrative unit should require as a prerequisite to any such
