(b155) <u>Pisgah Conservancy</u>. — The applicable requirements of G.S. 20-79.3A shall be met before the <u>Pisgah Conservancy plate may be developed</u>. The <u>Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of <u>Pisgah Conservancy plates</u> to The <u>Pisgah Conservancy to be used to provide support for the mission and goals of the Conservancy</u>.</u>

SECTION 5. The Revisor of Statutes is authorized to alphabetize, number, and renumber the special registration plates listed in G.S. 20-79.4(b) to ensure that all the special registration plates are listed in alphabetical order and numbered accordingly.

SECTION 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 2017.
