"SECTION 2.(c) Notwithstanding G.S. 163A-1112, the State Board of Elections and Ethics Enforcement shall comply with the following:

(1) Immediately prior to the placement of any of the judicial offices listed in subsection (b) of this section on the ballot, the following information shall be printed:

"No primaries for judicial office were held in 2018. The information listed by each of the following candidates' names indicates only the candidates' party affiliation or unaffiliated status on their voter registration at the time they filed to run for office."

(2) Immediately after the name of any individual candidate endorsed by the State Executive Committee of any political party in this State, the following information shall be printed:

"As endorsed by the [insert appropriate political party name].";

and on page 5, line 10, by inserting the following at the end of that line:

"On or before August 1, 2018, each State Executive Committee of any political party in this State shall submit to the State Board any endorsements of individual candidates for printing on the general election ballot."
