and nongovernmental agencies located within Buncombe County, including law enforcement		
agencies, to share only the information necessary to meet the objectives described in subsection		
(a) of this section. The Commissioners shall determine the criteria for membership on the Task		
Force and select and manage the composition of the Task Force; provided that a Task Force		
member may review and have access to records in a domestic violence fatality case only if:
