Requirements for renewing approval of individuals employed under this

SECTION 2.(b) G.S. 115C-295 reads as rewritten:

"§ 115C-295. Minimum age and certificate license prerequisites.

- (a) All teachers employed in the public schools of the State or in schools receiving public funds, shall be required either to hold or be qualified to hold a <u>certificate-license</u> in compliance with the provision of the law or in accordance with the regulations of the State Board of Education: Provided, that nothing herein shall prevent the employment of temporary personnel under such rules as the State Board of Education may prescribe: Provided further, that no person shall be employed to teach who is under 18 years of age.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any board of education to employ or keep in service any teacher who neither holds nor is qualified to hold a <u>certificate-license</u> in compliance with the provision of the law or in accordance with the regulations of the State Board of Education.
- (c) This section shall not prohibit the employment of individuals exempted from licensure under G.S. 115C-270.21."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.

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
