1 moves to amend the bill on page 5, lines 9-16, by rewriting the lines to read:

2 "(f) For purposes of this section, a "dispenser" includes a person licensed to practice
3 veterinary medicine pursuant to Article 11 of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes when that person
4 dispenses any Schedule II through V controlled substances. Notwithstanding subsection (b) of
5 this section, the Commission shall adopt rules requiring the information to be reported by a
6 person licensed to practice veterinary medicine pursuant to Article 11 of Chapter 90 of the
7 General Statutes.

8 (g) A person licensed to practice veterinary medicine pursuant to Article 11 of Chapter
9 90 of the General Statutes may submit prescription information by paper form or other means,
10 provided all information required of electronically submitted data is submitted.";

12 and on page 7, lines 1-3, by rewriting the lines to read:

13 "**SECTION 10.** Section 5 of this act becomes effective January 1, 2020. Section 6
14 of this act becomes effective January 1, 2019. G.S. 90-113.73(g), as enacted by Section 6 of this
15 act, expires effective October 1, 2019. Section 8 of this act is effective when it becomes law and
16 applies to renewal applications received in 2020. The remainder of this act is effective when it
17 becomes law."
