12 "SECTION 4.1. In addition to any other funds appropriated during the 2016-2017 fiscal year,  
13 there is appropriated from the Savings Reserve Account to the General Fund the sum of one  
14 hundred million nine hundred twenty-eight thousand three hundred seventy dollars  
15 (\$100,928,370) in nonrecurring funds for the 2016-2017 fiscal year and there is appropriated  
16 from the unappropriated General Fund balance the sum of one hundred million dollars  
17 (\$100,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. These funds shall be  
18 allocated as follows:

20 (6) \$5,000,000 shall be allocated to The Golden L.E.A.F. (Long-Term Economic  
21 Advancement Foundation), Inc., a nonprofit corporation, for the purpose of providing  
22 grants to eligible entities capable of making loans to small businesses affected by  
23 Hurricane Matthew, the western wildfires, or Tropical Storms Julia and Hermine. These  
24 funds shall not be subject to G.S. 143C-6-23(d) or G.S. 143C-6-23(f1)(1)."

25 "SECTION 2.(b) Effective July 18, 2017, subdivision (2) of Section 1 of S.L. 2017-  
26 119 reads as rewritten:

27 "SECTION 1. If Senate Bill 257 of the 2017 Regular Session becomes law, one hundred  
28 million dollars (\$100,000,000) reserved as Supplemental Disaster Recovery Funds in that act  
29 shall be allocated as follows:

30 ...

31 (2) Infrastructure. – Thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000) to the Golden L.E.A.F. (Long-  
32 Term Economic Advancement Foundation), Inc., a nonprofit corporation, to provide

1 grants to local governments and to 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporations for assistance and  
2 relief from Hurricane Matthew, the western wildfires, and Tropical Storms Julia and  
3 Hermine. These funds shall not be subject to G.S. 143C-6-23(d) or G.S. 143C-6-  
4 23(f1)(1). For purposes of this subdivision, infrastructure includes nonresidential  
5 buildings that serve the public, water, sewer, sidewalks, storm drainage, and other,  
6 similar projects.

8 **SECTION 3.** Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes  
9 law.”
