1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 7- 8, by rewriting the lines to read:

2 "BUSINESSES, ALLOWING CERTAIN NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO SPONSOR
3 SELF-FUNDED HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS, AND EXPANDING THE MASSAGE AND
4 BODYWORK THERAPY BOARD.";

6 and on page 19, lines 11 through 12, by inserting the following between those lines:

7 "SECTION 6.5. G.S. 90-625 reads as rewritten:

8 "**§ 90-625. North Carolina Board of Massage and Bodywork Therapy.**

9 (a) The North Carolina Board of Massage and Bodywork Therapy is created. The Board
10 shall consist of ~~seven~~nine members who are residents of this State and are as follows:

11 (1) Five members shall be massage and bodywork therapists who have been
12 licensed under this Article and have been in the practice of massage and
13 bodywork therapy for at least five of the last seven years prior to their serving
14 on the Board. Consideration shall be given to geographical distribution,
15 practice setting, clinical specialty, involvement in massage and bodywork
16 therapy education, and other factors that will promote diversity of the
17 profession on the Board. Two of the five members shall be appointed by the
18 General Assembly, upon the recommendation of the Speaker of the House of
19 Representatives, two shall be appointed by the General Assembly, upon the
20 recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and one shall be
21 appointed by the Governor.

22 (1a) Two members shall be persons holding a license to operate a massage and
23 bodywork therapy establishment under this Article. One of the two members
24 shall be appointed by the General Assembly upon the recommendation of the
25 Speaker of the House of Representatives and one shall be appointed by the
26 General Assembly upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of
27 the Senate.

28 (2) One member shall be a physician licensed pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 90
29 of the General Statutes or a person once licensed as a physician whose license
30 lapsed while the person was in good standing with the profession and eligible
31 for licensure. The appointment shall be made by the Governor and may be
32 made from a list provided by the North Carolina Medical Society.

1 (3) One member shall be a member of the general public who shall not be licensed
2 under Chapter 90 of the General Statutes or the spouse of a person who is so
3 licensed, or have any financial interest, directly or indirectly, in the profession
4 regulated under this Article. The appointment shall be made by the Governor.


5 (b) Legislative appointments shall be made in accordance with G.S. 120-121. A vacancy
6 in a legislative appointment shall be filled in accordance with G.S. 120-122.

7 (c) Each member of the Board shall serve for a term of three years, ending on June 30 of
8 the last year of the term. A member shall not be appointed to serve more than two consecutive
9 terms.
