8 on page 3, lines 37-39, by rewriting the lines to read:

9 "c. The request is reasonably related to a bona fide active investigation
10 involving a specific violation of any State or federal law involving a
11 monitored prescription drug and except for requests for the purpose of
12 regulatory compliance, a court order based on probable cause has been
13 issued by a superior court judge, district court judge, or magistrate with
14 any jurisdiction in the State." *Reives*
