The county board of elections under the direction of the Bipartisan State Board of Elections and Ethics Enforcement, shall make necessary provisions for elections for mayor and councilmembers.";

The term of office of the mayor and six councilmembers shall be four years, and shall be so staggered that the terms of office of three councilmembers shall expire every two years. Said staggered terms shall begin following In the election of 1997, 2020, with those three persons elected to council who receive the highest number of votes of the entire council from District 1, District 2, and from the City at-large to-will serve four year terms to expire in 2001, 2024. In the election of 2022, the and the other three persons elected to council from District 3, District 4, and District 5 will to serve two-four year terms to expire in 1999-2026. Commencing with the 1999-2020 election, all terms of office for council members shall be four years.";
