A SENATE RESOLUTION HONORING THE CITIZENS OF THE TOWN OF BATH AND	
THE PAMLICO SOUND REGION FOR THE CONTRIBUTIONS THEY HAVE MADE	
TO THE	
	hereas, Bath was incorporated by the General Assembly on March 8, 1705,
becoming the State's first town; and	
	hereas, Bath served as the county seat from 1696 to 1785 and the site of Beaufort
County's first courthouse, which was built in 1723; and	
	hereas, in 1715, North Carolina Governor Charles Eden petitioned the Lords
Proprietors to establish Port Bath and, after receiving approval, proclaimed Port Bath the first	
official port of entry on August 1, 1716, making it possible for ships and vessels to import and	
export goods to and from the colony. Port Bath was operational between 1716 and the 1790s;	
and	
	hereas, Bath is the site of the State's oldest exiting church, St. Thomas Church,
which was established in Bath in 1734, and is the location of the State's first public library, which	
	ed in 1701 with 1,000 books sent from England to St. Thomas Parrish; and
	hereas, Bath hosted the General Assembly in 1744 and 1752 and was once
	location for the capital of the colony; and hereas, 300 years ago, Edward Teach, the infamous pirate known as Blackbeard,
	s crew, spent several months in Bath. In 1996, the wreckage of Blackbeard's flagship
the "Queen Anne's Revenge" was discovered near the Beaufort Inlet; and	
	hereas, Bath's lasting legacy provides visitors with vast opportunities to learn about
	ltural, religious, historical, and maritime heritage of the Pamlico Sound region;
Now, therefore,	
Be it resolved by the Senate:
