3 **"AMEND IMPLEMENTATION OF VOTER ID CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT**

4 **SECTION 22.10.(d)** If Senate Bill 824, 2017 Regular Session, becomes law, then
5 G.S. 163A-1145.1(d1), as enacted by that act, reads as rewritten:

6 "(d1) Reasonable Impediment Declaration Form. – The State Board shall adopt a
7 reasonable impediment declaration form that, at a minimum, includes the following as separate
8 boxes that a registered voter may check to identify the registered voter's reasonable impediment:

- 9 (1) Inability to obtain photo identification due to:
 - 10 a. Lack of transportation.
 - 11 b. Disability or illness.
 - 12 c. Lack of birth certificate or other underlying documents required.
 - 13 d. Work or school schedule.
 - 14 e. Family responsibilities.
- 15 (2) Lost or stolen photo identification.
- 16 (3) Photo identification applied for but not yet received by the registered voter
17 voting in person.
- 18 (4) Other reasonable impediment. If the registered voter checks the "other
19 reasonable impediment" box, a further brief written identification of the
20 reasonable impediment shall be required, including the option to indicate that
21 State or federal law prohibits listing the impediment."".
