SECTION 1. Article 14A of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by		
adding a new section to read:		
"§ 115C-218.37. Public approval for private activity bonds.		
	or purposes of this section, the following definitions shall apply:	
<u>(1</u>	1) Charter school facility. – Real property, personal property, or both that is	
	or intended for use in connection with the operation of a charter school.	
<u>(2</u>	2) Applicable elected representative. – An elected official of a governmenta	
	having jurisdiction over the area in which a charter school facility is lo	cated,
	as defined in the Internal Revenue Code.	
<u>(b)</u> <u>T</u>	he Superintendent of Public Instruction is hereby designated as an applicable e	<u>lected</u>
representative who may approve the issuance of one or more private activity bonds to finance or		
refinance a charter school facility, after a public hearing following reasonable public notice, in		
accordance with Section 147 of the Internal Revenue Code and applicable State and federal laws		
and regulations. Procedures for the public hearing shall be determined by the Superintendent of		
Public Instruction, and the public hearing shall be conducted by the Superintendent or his or her		
designee."		

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
