A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO ALLOW ANY CITIZEN TO REMOVE A POLITICAL SIGN THAT REMAINS 3 IN A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY THIRTY DAYS AFTER THE TIME WITHIN WHICH 4 POLITICAL SIGNS ARE TO BE REMOVED. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 136-32 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(e1) Notwithstanding subsection (e) of this section, a political sign that remains in a public 7 right-of-way after 30 days from the date political signs are to be removed pursuant to subsection 8 (b) of this section shall be considered abandoned property, and a citizen may remove the political 9 10 sign and dispose of it without penalty." SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2019, and applies to offenses 11 12 committed on or after that date.



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
