The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. G.S. 14-362 reads as rewritten:
"§ 14-362. Cockfighting.
A person who instigates, promotes, conducts, is employed at, allows property under his
ownership or control to be used for, participates as a spectator at, <u>causes a person under 16 years</u>
of age to be present at, or profits from from, an exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is
guilty of a Class I felony. A lease of property that is used or is intended to be used for an
exhibition featuring the fighting of a cock is void, and a lessor who knows this use is made or is
intended to be made of his property is under a duty to evict the lessee immediately."
SECTION 2. G.S. 14-362.1 reads as rewritten:
"§ 14-362.1. Animal fights and baiting, other than cock fights, dog fights and dog baiting.
