The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Health and Human Services the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000)
for the 2019-2020 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars
(\$175,000) for the 2020-2021 fiscal year in recurring funds used to provide a grant-in-aid to
North Carolina Senior Games, Inc., to provide funds for the North Carolina Senior Games
Program, which is designed to inspire, motivate, and educate all citizens about their potential for
good health and involvement in physical activity throughout their lives, and to improve the

quantity and quality of physical activity programs in the State by providing healthy, competitive,

and athletic experiences for older adults. **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2019.
