- Upon a person's first conviction for an animal abuse offense, the Bureau shall (c) maintain the person's name and other identifying information, described in subsection (a) of this section, for two years following the date of conviction, after which time the Bureau shall remove the person's name and identifying information from the list; provided that the person is not convicted of another animal abuse offense during that two-year period.
- Upon a person's subsequent conviction for an animal abuse offense, the Bureau shall maintain the person's name and other identifying information, described in subsection (a) of this section, for five years following the date of the most recent conviction, after which time the Bureau shall remove the person's name and identifying information from the list; provided that the person is not convicted of another animal abuse offense during that five-year period.
- The Bureau shall remove a person's name and identifying information from the registry list if the sole offense for which the person is required to be subject to the mandates of the registry is expunged."

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2020.
