The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. The Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Office of Archives		
and History, shall evaluate the real property and textile collection held by the Randolph Heritage		
Conservancy, Inc., located in the Town of Franklinville, to determine the feasibility of its use in		
establishing a State historic site or State museum to interpret the State's textile production and		
industrial history. By May 1, 2020, the Commission shall report its findings and		
recommendations to the Randolph County Board of County Commissioners, the Randolph		
Heritage Conservancy, Inc., and the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Agriculture and
