SECTION 1. G.S. 143B-437.02A reads as rewritten:	
"§ 143B-437.02A. The Film and Entertainment Grant Fund.	
(a) Creation and Purpose of Fund. – There is created in the Department of Commerce

percent (25%) of the qualifying expenses for any other production.

dollars (\$250,000) for a commercial for theatrical or television

1 2 3 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Film and Entertainment Grant Fund an additional nineteen million dollars (\$19,000,000) in recurring funds for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 fiscal years for purposes consistent with the Fund.

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SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act is effective when it becomes law and applies to grants made on or after that date. Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2019. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.

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
