The General	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 136-27.1(b) reads as rewritten:		
"(b) A	a municipality with a population of greater than 10,000 shall pay a percentage	of the
nonbettermer	nt cost for relocation of water and sewer lines owned by the municipality and le	ocated
within the ex	tisting State transportation project right-of-way that are necessary to be relocated	ted for
	portation improvement project. The percentage shall be based on the municip	ality's
population, with the Department paying the remaining costs, as follows:		
(1	1) A municipality with a population of greater than 10,000, but less than 2	5,000,
	shall pay twenty-five percent (25%) of the cost.	
(2	2) A municipality with a population of 25,000 or greater, but less than 5	0,000,
	than 100,000, shall pay fifty percent (50%) of the cost.	
(3	A municipality with a population of 50,000 of 100,000 or greater sha	ıll pay
	one hundred percent (100%) of the cost."	
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
