1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO ENACT THE RELIGIOUS ASSEMBLY SECURITY AND PROTECTION ACT  
3 OF 2019.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known as "The Religious Assembly Security and  
6 Protection Act of 2019."

7 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 14-269.2(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

8 "(1c) School operating hours. – Any time when curricular or extracurricular  
9 activities are taking place on the premises and any time when the premises are  
10 being used for educational, instructional, or school-sponsored activities."

11 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 14-269.2 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

12 "(k1) The provisions of this section shall not apply to a person who has a concealed handgun  
13 permit that is valid under Article 54B of this Chapter, or who is exempt from obtaining a permit  
14 pursuant to that Article, if all of the following conditions apply:

15 (1) The person possesses and carries a handgun on educational property that is  
16 not an institution of higher education as defined by G.S. 116-143.1 or a  
17 nonpublic, postsecondary educational institution.

18 (2) The educational property is the location of both a school and a building that is  
19 a place of religious worship.

20 (3) The weapon is a handgun.

21 (4) The handgun is only possessed and carried on educational property outside of  
22 the school operating hours.

23 For the purposes of this subsection, a building that is a place of religious worship is as defined  
24 in G.S. 14-54.1, but does not include property owned by a local board of education or county  
25 commission."

26 **SECTION 4.** G.S. 14-415.11(c) reads as rewritten:

27 "(c) Except as provided in G.S. 14-415.27, a permit does not authorize a person to carry  
28 a concealed handgun in any of the following:

29 (1) Areas prohibited by G.S. 14-269.2, ~~14-269.3, and 14-277.2.~~except as allowed  
30 under G.S. 14-269.2(k1).

31 (1a) Areas prohibited by G.S. 14-269.3 and G.S. 14-277.2.

32 ...."

33 **SECTION 5.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2019, and applies to offenses  
34 committed on or after that date.



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
