2 "request of the witness. Notwithstanding subsection (e) of this section, the ~~record~~records gathered  
3 in the course of the grand jury investigation and the record of the examination of witnesses shall  
4 be made available to the examining prosecutor, and ~~he may~~shall become part of the file of the  
5 prosecutor's office as those terms are defined by G.S. 15A-903(a)(1). The prosecutor may  
6 disclose contents of the record to other investigative or law-enforcement officers, the witness or  
7 ~~his~~the witness' attorney to the extent that the disclosure is appropriate to the proper performance  
8 of his official duties. The record of the examination of a witness may be used in a trial to the  
9 extent that".
