9 SECTION 40.24. Notwithstanding any other provision of this act to the contrary, of 10 the funds appropriated to the Highway Fund, Reserves, Transfers, and Other the sum of four 11 million nine hundred fifty-eight thousand eight hundred eighty-one dollars (\$4,958,881) for the 12 2019-2020 fiscal year and fourteen million nine hundred two thousand nine hundred eighty five 13 dollars (\$14,902,985) for the 2020-2021 fiscal year shall be allocated as follows:

- 14(1)Nine hundred eighty-seven thousand four hundred twenty-one dollars15(\$987,421) for the 2019-2020 fiscal year and three million six hundred sixty-16six thousand two hundred seven dollars (\$3,662,207) for the 2020-2021 fiscal17year in recurring funds for increased employer costs of the health benefit18coverage for active employees utilizing the State Health Plan.
- 19(2)Three million eight hundred thousand two hundred seventy-six dollars20(\$3,800,276) for the 2019-2020 fiscal year and ten million ninety-nine21thousand eight hundred thirty-two dollars (\$10,099,832) for the 2020-202122fiscal year in recurring funds for the actuarially determined contribution and23increased retiree medical premiums, and a one percent (1.0%) one-time cost-24of-living supplement to retirees in FY 2020-21 in the amount of nine hundred25sixty-nine thousand seven hundred sixty-two dollars (\$969,762).
 - (3) One hundred seventy-one thousand one hundred eighty-four dollars (\$171,184) in recurring funds for each year of the 2019-2021 biennium for the payment of short-term disability benefits."; and
- 30 on page 124, line 32, through page 139, line 41, by re-designating Section 9B.9 as Section 9G.10

31 and moving it to Part IX-G; and





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1 on page 10, lines 33 and 51, by substituting "244550-2260" with "24550-2260"; and 2 3 on page 257, line 9, by inserting the phrase "Section 38.17 of" before the word "this"; and 4 5 on page 22, lines 43-44, by inserting the following between the lines: 6 "2020 CENSUS PREPARATION RESERVE 7 SECTION 5.7. Of the funds appropriated in this act, the sum of four hundred 8 thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the 2019-2010 fiscal year shall be transferred from the OSHR 9 Minimum of Market Reserve and the sum of three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) for the 2019-2020 fiscal year shall be transferred from the Pending Legislation Reserve, to the 2020 10 Census Preparation Reserve (Reserve) created in this section. The seven hundred fifty thousand 11 12 dollars (\$750,000) in the Reserve shall be managed by the Office of State Budget and Management and used for materials and outreach related to statewide preparation for the 2020 13 14 United States Census.": and 15
