1 moves to amend the bill on page 216, lines 27-28, by inserting the following new provision
2 between those lines:

3 **"ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR EMERGING COMPOUNDS**

4 **SECTION 12.13.(a)** Notwithstanding anything in this act or the associated
5 committee report to the contrary, of the funds appropriated by this act to the Department of
6 Commerce for the Job Development Investment Grant Program the sum of two million five
7 hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) in recurring funds shall instead be allocated to the
8 Department of Environmental Quality for personnel, equipment, and supplies to increase
9 detection and prevention of water and air contamination and to conduct analysis of emerging
10 compounds.

11 **SECTION 12.13.(b)** G.S. 143B-437.020(g) reads as rewritten:

12 "(g) Allocation of Funds. – The Secretary shall transfer from the Utility Account to the
13 Expanded Gas Products Service to Agriculture Fund at least five million dollars (\$5,000,000) per
14 biennium, as defined in G.S. 143C-1-1. ~~If funds appropriated for the Job Development~~
15 ~~Investment Grant Program, the One North Carolina Fund, or a combination of these programs~~
16 ~~remain unexpended and unencumbered at the end of the fiscal year, those unexpended and~~
17 ~~unencumbered funds shall be used to reimburse the Utility Account for transfers made during the~~
18 ~~fiscal year pursuant to this section, notwithstanding job creation or other statutory requirements~~
19 ~~otherwise applicable to the programs or funds."";~~
