Short Title: School Calendar Flexibility/Cleveland County. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY TO THE CLEVELAND COUNTY
3 BOARD OF EDUCATION IN ADOPTING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates of
7 opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for
8 year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than ~~the Monday closest to~~
9 ~~August 26, August 10,~~ and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest
10 to June 11. ~~On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement~~
11 ~~that the opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may~~
12 ~~allow the local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to~~
13 ~~August 19, to the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate~~
14 ~~anticipated makeup days due to school closings.~~ A local board may revise the scheduled closing
15 date if necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional days or
16 instructional time. ~~For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in~~
17 ~~any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year during any~~
18 ~~four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures,~~
19 ~~or other emergency situations.~~

20 The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school
21 that a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to
22 any school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of
23 modified calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."

24 **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to Cleveland County Schools.

25 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
26 the 2019-2020 school year.
