1 moves to amend the bill on page 124, lines 30-31, by inserting between the lines a new section
 2 to read:
 3 **"DHHS VACANT POSITION ELIMINATION FLEXIBILITY AND REPORT**
 4 **SECTION 9B.9.** Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary, the
 5 Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services (Secretary) may achieve the savings
 6 from vacant position eliminations for each year of the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium by (i)
 7 substituting alternative positions to be eliminated or (ii) reducing other operating funds. By
 8 October 1, 2019, and October 1, 2020, the Secretary shall submit a report to the Joint Legislative
 9 Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services, the House of Representatives
 10 Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Services, the Senate Appropriations
 11 Committee on Health and Human Services, and the Fiscal Research Division on the actions taken
 12 to achieve the budgeted reduction for vacant position eliminations for the fiscal year. If
 13 alternative positions are eliminated, the report shall include a list of each alternative position
 14 eliminated, along with its position number, title, and the amount of salary and fringe benefits
 15 associated with each position."; and

 17 by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
