HOUSE BILL DRH40074-MW-43

Short Title: Powell Bill/Use For Parks. (Public)

Sponsors: Representatives Conrad and Lambeth (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PERMIT CITIES AND TOWNS WITH A POPULATION OF 3,000 OR LESS
3 AND NO MORE THAN ONE MILE OF PUBLIC STREETS TO USE POWELL BILL
4 FUNDS FOR THE PLANNING, CONSTRUCTION, AND MAINTENANCE OF PARKS.
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 136-41.3(a) reads as rewritten:
7 "(a) Uses of Funds. – Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the funds allocated
8 to cities and towns under the provisions of G.S. 136-41.2 shall be expended by said cities and
9 towns primarily for the resurfacing of streets within the corporate limits of the municipality but
10 may also be used for the purposes of maintaining, repairing, constructing, reconstructing or
11 widening of any street or public thoroughfare including bridges, drainage, curb and gutter, and
12 other necessary appurtenances within the corporate limits of the municipality or for meeting the
13 municipality's proportionate share of assessments levied for such purposes, or for the planning,
14 construction and maintenance of bikeways, greenways, or sidewalks. For cities and towns that
15 have a population of 3,000 or less and no more than 1 mile of public streets, the funds allocated
16 under the provisions of G.S. 136-41.2 may be expended for the planning, construction, and
17 maintenance of parks. The funds allocated to cities and towns under the provisions of
18 G.S. 136-41.2 shall not be expended for the construction of a sidewalk into which is built a
19 mailbox, utility pole, fire hydrant, or other similar obstruction that would impede the clear
20 passage of pedestrians on the sidewalk."
21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to funds received
22 before, on, or after that date.
