8 "**§ 95-25.3. Minimum wage.**

9 (a) Every employer shall pay to each employee who in any workweek performs any work,
10 wages of at least six dollars and fifteen cents (\$6.15) per hour or the minimum wage set forth in
11 paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor Standards Act, 29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1), as that wage
12 may change from time to time, whichever is higher, except as otherwise provided in this
13 section: the following amounts:

- 14 (1) Effective on January 1, 2020, eight dollars (\$8.00) per hour or the minimum
15 wage set forth in paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor Standards Act,
16 29 U.S.C. § 206(a)(1), as that wage may change from time to time, whichever
17 is higher, except as otherwise provided in this section.
18 (2) Effective on January 1, 2021, ten dollars and thirty-five cents (\$10.35) per
19 hour or the minimum wage set forth in paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair
20 Labor Standards Act, 29 U.S.C. § 206(a)(1), as that wage may change from
21 time to time, whichever is higher, except as otherwise provided in this section.
22 (3) Effective on January 1, 2022, twelve dollars (\$12.00) per hour or the minimum
23 wage set forth in paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor Standards Act,
24 29 U.S.C. § 206(a)(1), as that wage may change from time to time, whichever
25 is higher, except as otherwise provided in this section.
26 (4) Effective on January 1, 2023, thirteen dollars and fifty cents (\$13.50) per hour
27 or the minimum wage set forth in paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor
28 Standards Act, 29 U.S.C. § 206(a)(1), as that wage may change from time to
29 time, whichever is higher, except as otherwise provided in this section.
30 (5) Effective on January 1, 2024, fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per hour or the minimum
31 wage set forth in paragraph 1 of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor Standards Act,



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1 29 U.S.C. § 206(a)(1), as that wage may change from time to time, whichever
2 is higher, except as otherwise provided in this section."
3 **SECTION 6.** This act is effective when it becomes law."
