1 moves to amend the PCS on page 133, line 22, by deleting the phrase "for services provided" and
2 substituting the phrase "for the delivery of services";

4 and moves to amend the PCS on page 263, lines 34-35, by inserting between those lines the
5 following new section:

6 **"E-PROCUREMENT SYSTEM FUNDS**

7 **SECTION 37.4.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State
8 Chief Information Officer (SCIO) shall provide for the replacement of the State's e-procurement
9 system for State agencies, departments, and institutions, and the approval of the SCIO is required
10 for all expenditures from the reserve established in this act for that purpose.";

12 and moves to amend the PCS on page 190, lines 31-32, by inserting between those lines the
13 following language:

14 **"ROWLAND FUNDING CLARIFICATION**

15 **SECTION 11.8.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, funds
16 appropriated to the Rural Economic Development Fund by S.L. 2018-5 and allocated to the Town
17 of Rowland for road signage improvements shall instead be used for renovation, restoration, and
18 preservation work on the Rowland train depot.";

20 and moves to amend the PCS on page 103, lines 15-16, by deleting the phrase "for the 2020-2021
21 fiscal year";

23 and moves to amend the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget Committee Report, dated May 29,
24 2019, on page D28, by adding a new item in the Commerce-State Aid section for fund code 1122
25 that provides for a recurring reduction of \$350,000 in funding for the High Point Furniture
26 Market;

28 and moves to amend the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget Committee Report, dated May 29,
29 2019, on page D75, by adding a new item in the Natural and Cultural Resources section for fund
30 code 1340 that provides for a recurring appropriation of \$350,000 in additional funding for the
31 North Carolina Symphony and provides that \$50,000 of the funds appropriated shall be used to
32 provide access to Symphony performances for public schools without transportation;


