moves to amend the PCS on page 133, line 22, by deleting the phrase "for services provided" and substituting the phrase "for the delivery of services";

and moves to amend the PCS on page 263, lines 34-35, by inserting between those lines the following new section:

#### "E-PROCUREMENT SYSTEM FUNDS

**SECTION 37.4.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the State Chief Information Officer (SCIO) shall provide for the replacement of the State's e-procurement system for State agencies, departments, and institutions, and the approval of the SCIO is required for all expenditures from the reserve established in this act for that purpose.";

and moves to amend the PCS on page 190, lines 31-32, by inserting between those lines the following language:

### "ROWLAND FUNDING CLARIFICATION

**SECTION 11.8.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, funds appropriated to the Rural Economic Development Fund by S.L. 2018-5 and allocated to the Town of Rowland for road signage improvements shall instead be used for renovation, restoration, and preservation work on the Rowland train depot.";

and moves to amend the PCS on page 103, lines 15-16, by deleting the phrase "for the 2020-2021 fiscal year";

and moves to amend the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget Committee Report, dated May 29, 2019, on page D28, by adding a new item in the Commerce-State Aid section for fund code 1122 that provides for a recurring reduction of \$350,000 in funding for the High Point Furniture Market;

 and moves to amend the Senate Appropriations/Base Budget Committee Report, dated May 29, 2019, on page D75, by adding a new item in the Natural and Cultural Resources section for fund code 1340 that provides for a recurring appropriation of \$350,000 in additional funding for the North Carolina Symphony and provides that \$50,000 of the funds appropriated shall be used to provide access to Symphony performances for public schools without transportation;
