"AN ACT TO REQUIRE A MINIMUM SIZE LIMIT FOR CERTAIN SPECIES OF MARINE FISH TO ENSURE THAT SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF THE JUVENILE FISH OF THE SPECIES WILL HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO REACH MATURITY AND SPAWN AT LEAST ONCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 113-182.1(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: Include a minimum size limit for spot (Leiostomus xanthurus), Atlantic croaker "(8)(Micropogonias" and

15 16 "life history data currently available for spot (Leiostomus xanthurus), Atlantic croaker (Micropogonias undulatus), kingfishes (Menticirrhus ssp.), striped mullet (Mugil cephalus), 17 southern flounder (Paralichthys lethostigma), and bluefish (Pomatomus saltatrix). No later than 18 December 1, 2019, the Director shall present the findings of this review to the Commission. 19 20 Based on these findings, the Commission shall adopt temporary management measures that

establish minimum size limits to ensure that seventy-five percent (75%) of the juvenile fish at

22 the minimum size limit established for these species will reach the size of maturity and will have 23 an opportunity to spawn at least once.".
