- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 5-7, by rewriting those lines to read:
- 2 "TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL
- 3 CAREER AND COLLEGE READINESS INFORMATION ON ANNUAL REPORT CARDS,
- 4 AND TO ALLOW CERTAIN LOTTERY WINNERS TO REMAIN ANONYMOUS FOR
- 5 NINETY DAYS.";
- 6
- 7 and on page 2, lines 45-46, by rewriting those lines to read:
- 8 "SECTION 5. G.S. 18C-132 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 9 "(j1) If requested by the prize winner, the identity of a prize winner of fifty million dollars
- 10 (\$50,000,000) or more shall be treated as confidential information under G.S. 132-1.2(8) until 90
- 11 days after the winner has claimed the prize."
- 12 SECTION 6. G.S. 132-1.2 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
- 13 "(8) Reveals the name, address, or other identifying information of any individual winning
- 14 more than fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) in a lottery game who requests to remain
- 15 anonymous for 90 days, as provided in G.S. 18C-132(j1)."
- 16 SECTION 7. This act is effective when it becomes law. Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 apply
- 17 to measures based on data from the 2018-2019 school year and each school year thereafter."
