1	moves to amend the bill on page 4, line 20, by rewriting the line to read:

- 3 "of the State prison system beyond the initial 30-day period. If the judge determines that the
- 4 prisoner should remain in the custody of the Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice,
- 5 the judge shall renew the order and include a date certain for review by the court. Prior to the
- 6 date of review, the Division shall conduct a reassessment of treatment and venue needs and the
- 7 sheriff shall provide the reassessment and any other relevant information to the court, as
- 8 described in this subsection. If the judge determines that the prisoner should not remain in the
- 9 custody of the Division of Adult Correction and Juvenile Justice, the officer in charge of the
- 10 <u>prison</u>";

"SECTION 3. This act becomes effective October 1, 2019, and applies to all
prisoners transferred on or after that date.".
