1 moves to amend the bill on page 13, line 5 through page 14, line 7, by rewriting the lines to read:

3 "SECTION 11. Article 38 of Chapter 7B of the General Statutes is amended by
4 adding a new section to read:

5 "**§ 7B-3807. Adoption of the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children Regulations.**

6 The Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children regulations and any subsequent
7 amendments that are adopted by the Association of Administrators of the Interstate Compact on
8 the Placement of Children of the American Public Human Service Association are hereby enacted
9 into law and shall apply to all interstate placements of children between North Carolina and
10 jurisdictions that are a party to this Compact."

11 SECTION 12. Article 38 of Chapter 7B of the General Statutes is amended by adding
12 a new section to read:

13 "**§ 7B-3808. Action for Interstate Compact Administrator to Forward a Request.**

14 The Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children office at the Department of Health and
15 Human Services has the authority to request supporting or additional information necessary to
16 carry out the purpose and policy of the compact and to require assurance that the placement meets
17 all applicable North Carolina placement statutes. Any sending agency that intends to place a child
18 into and out of North Carolina shall submit a complete request to the Interstate Compact on the
19 Placement of Children office at the Department of Health and Human Services. To be considered
20 a complete request, the submission must comply with the Interstate Compact on the Placement
21 of Children regulations and include any supporting additional information that the Department
22 of Health and Human Services or the receiving state deems necessary. Unless otherwise provided
23 by the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children regulations, when the Department of
24 Health and Human Services receives an incomplete request, the Department of Health and
25 Human Services shall provide either the sending agency in North Carolina or the receiving state
26 with written notice of the specific information needed to process the request and shall allow the
27 sending agency 10 business days from the date of the notice to submit the requested information.
28 If after the expiration of the 10 business days the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children
29 office at the Department of Health and Human Services does not receive the requested
30 information or the sending agency does not withdraw its request, the request shall be deemed
31 expired."
