Senator Perry

1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 25, by rewriting the line to read:

2 "current address of the driver the TNC has on record at the time the driver's
3 relationship with the TNC ended, in this State for one year from the date the
4 TNC driver";

6 and on page 1, line 30, by inserting the phrase "and contrasting" between the words "legible" and
7 "font";

8
9 and on page 1, line 31, by deleting the phrase "two inches" and substituting the phrase "three
10 inches";

11
12 and on page 2, lines 1-11, by rewriting those lines to read:

13 "(e) Except as provided in subsection (f) of this section, a transportation network company
14 must require a TNC driver to display consistent and distinctive signage or emblems, known as a
15 trade dress, trademark, branding, or logo of the TNC, on the TNC driver's vehicle at all times
16 when the TNC driver is active on the TNC digital platform or when providing any TNC service
17 that reasonably assists customers to identify or verify a TNC driver responding to a ride request.
18 TNC signage or emblems required by this subsection may include magnetic or removable signage
19 or emblems, must be approved by the Division before use, and must meet all of the following
20 requirements:

21 (1) Be readable during daylight hours at a distance of 50 feet.

22 (2) Include an illuminated TNC-provided sign displaying the TNC's proprietary
23 trademark or logo that is clearly visible so as to be seen in darkness.

24 (f) A transportation network company may seek approval from the Division for
25 technological identifiers as an alternative to the distinctive signage or emblems required by
26 subsection (e) of this section. The Division may approve an alternative technological identifier
27 if it reasonably assists customers to identify or verify a TNC driver responding to a ride request.
28 If approved by the Division, the approved technological identifier must be used by a TNC driver
29 at all times when the TNC driver is active on the TNC digital platform or when providing any
30 TNC service."

31 **SECTION 2.(b)** G.S. 20-280.5(e) and (f), as enacted by this section, become
32 effective July 1, 2020. The remainder of this section becomes effective October 1, 2019."
