"SECTION 5.5.(a)	G.S. 136-131.2 reads as rewritten:
-------------------------	------------------------------------

- "§ 136-131.2. Modernization of outdoor advertising devices.
- 5 (a) No municipality, county, local or regional zoning authority, or other political 6 subdivision shall, without the payment of just compensation as provided for in G.S. 136-131.1, 7 regulate or prohibit the repair or reconstruction of any outdoor advertising for which there is in 8 effect a valid permit issued by the Department of Transportation so long as the square footage of 9 its advertising surface area is not increased.

10 (b) As used in this section, reconstruction includes the changing of an existing multipole 11 outdoor advertising structure to a new monopole structure.

12 (c) As used in this Article, reconstruction shall not include conversion of the outdoor
13 advertising to any of the following:

- (1) <u>An automatic changeable facing sign.</u>
- (2) <u>The display of flashing, intermittent, or moving lights, including animated or scrolling advertising.</u>"

17 **SECTION 5.5.(b)** G.S. 136-131.2(c), as enacted by this act, is effective when it 18 becomes law and expires December 31, 2022.".
