17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28	(b) Handicapped Car Owners; Distinguishing License Plates. – If the handicapped person is a registered owner of a vehicle, vehicle is handicapped or the registered owner certifies that the registered owner is the guardian or parent of a handicapped person, the registered owner may apply for and display a distinguishing license plate. This license plate shall be issued for the normal fee applicable to standard license plates. Any vehicle owner who qualifies for a distinguishing license plate shall be notified by the Division at the time the plate is issued that the applicant is also eligible to receive one removable windshield placard and, upon request, shall be issued a placard at that time. A vehicle with a distinguishing license plate may be lawfully used when a handicapped person is not a driver or passenger so long as the vehicle is not using handicapped privileges including parking in a space designated with a sign pursuant to subsection (d) of this section.	<u>t</u> y a t l y <u>n</u>				
29 30 31 32	(c) Handicapped Drivers and Passengers; Distinguishing Placards. – A handicapped person may apply for the issuance of a removable windshield placard or a temporary removable windshield placard. Upon request, one additional placard may be issued to applicants who do not have a distinguishing license plate. Any organization which, as determined and certified by the	e t				

33 State Vocational Rehabilitation Agency, regularly transports handicapped persons may also



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1 apply. These organizations may receive one removable windshield placard for each transporting 2 vehicle. When the removable windshield or temporary removable windshield placard is properly 3 displayed, all parking rights and privileges extended to vehicles displaying a distinguishing license plate issued pursuant to subsection (b) shall apply. The removable windshield placard or 4 5 the temporary removable windshield placard shall be displayed so that it may be viewed from 6 the front and rear of the vehicle by hanging it from the front windshield rearview mirror of a 7 vehicle using a parking space allowed for handicapped persons. When there is no inside rearview 8 mirror, or when the placard cannot reasonably be hung from the rearview mirror by the 9 handicapped person, the placard shall be displayed on the driver's side of the dashboard. A 10 removable windshield placard placed on a motorized wheelchair or similar vehicle shall be 11 displayed in a clearly visible location. The Division shall establish procedures for the issuance 12 of the placards and may charge a fee sufficient to pay the actual cost of issuance, but in no event 13 less than five dollars (\$5.00) per placard. The Division shall issue a placard registration card with 14 each placard issued to a handicapped person. The registration card shall bear the name of the 15 person to whom the placard is issued, the person's address, the placard number, and an expiration 16 date. The registration card shall be in the vehicle in which the placard is being used, and the 17 person to whom the placard is issued shall be the operator or a passenger in the vehicle in which 18 the placard is displayed.

19 (c1) Application and Renewal; Medical Certification. - The initial application for a 20 distinguishing license plate, removable windshield placard, or temporary removable windshield 21 placard shall be accompanied by a certification of a licensed physician, a licensed 22 ophthalmologist, a licensed optometrist, a licensed physician assistant, a licensed nurse 23 practitioner, or the Division of Services for the Blind that the applicant or person in the applicant's 24 custody or care is handicapped or by a disability determination by the United States Department 25 of Veterans Affairs that the applicant or person in the applicant's custody or care is handicapped. 26 For an initial application for a temporary removable windshield placard only, the certification 27 that the applicant is handicapped may be made by a licensed certified nurse midwife. The 28 application for a temporary removable windshield placard shall contain additional certification 29 to include the period of time the certifying authority determines the applicant will have the 30 disability. Distinguishing license plates shall be renewed annually, but subsequent applications 31 shall not require a medical certification that the applicant is handicapped. handicapped, except 32 that a registered owner that certified pursuant to subsection (b) of this section that the registered 33 owner is the guardian or parent of a handicapped person must recertify every five years. 34 Removable windshield placards shall be renewed every five years, and, except for a person 35 certified as totally and permanently disabled at the time of the initial application or a prior 36 renewal under this subsection, the renewal shall require a medical recertification that the person 37 is handicapped; provided that a medical certification shall not be required to renew any placard 38 that expires after the person to whom it is issued is 80 years of age. Temporary removable 39 windshield placards shall expire no later than six months after issuance.
